And also thanks a lot for the yummy potluck food! The pictures are now available on Picassa; so check them out.



- Pool Day! On Friday July 16, we are having a pool party from 12:00 pm until 2:00 pm. We will be meeting at the Columbus Grove Swimming pool by the Sweet Shade Park. Parents must be there at all times. A teacher will be in the classroom, therefore the children who do not want to go to the pool, will have a regular day in school. If you would like to join us at the pool, please pick up your child from the preschool and then bring him/her to the event.
