- O Please at drop off; be punctual as it can be disruptive to the children doing their regular Montessori jobs. Circle time starts at 9:00AM. Please do not ring the bell Knock on the door and open it gently and encourage your child to come in quietly while bringing their own lunch box.
- o Submit all tuition installments by the 25th of each month prior to attendance to avoid the late fee.
- o While at MFT, Don't use the cell phones/blue tooth to give your child all your attention.
- o If you send a food item to be warmed, it must be in a small microwave safe dish with your child's name clearly marked.
- o If you have some plans during the school year and your child will not able to attend the MFT, please notify the preschool at least one month ahead. We will need to know to plan the spots accordingly.
